

Accreditation Guidelines

MARCH OF THE NATIONS IN JERUSALEM

We are pleased that you wish to report on the March of the Nations and the associated events. While the March itself is a public event, the Conference and final event at Sultan's Pool are free for the Press only upon prior registration and accreditation. Accreditation is solely for the purpose of journalistic reporting.

Press Accreditations can be obtained by:

1. A holder of a valid Press Card from a national or foreign Journalist's Association
2. Holders of a valid Press Card issued by a national or foreign Specialist Journalist's Association with a thematic reference
3. Persons from home or abroad who can prove their journalistic (also photo-journalistic) activity as follows:
 - Proof of a written editorial order with reference to the subject event "March of the Nations" (this also applies to trainees and volunteers who attend the events accompanied by an editor)
 - Presentation of an imprint in the original in which you are named as an author, editor or editorial employee
 - Submission of a receipt which authorizes you to carry out press work for a public authority, an institution or a non-profit organization or identifies you as a Press Officer of an association.

If deemed necessary, further verification of proof of journalistic activity may be required when you are presenting a Press Card to the Press Office of the March of Life e.V.

Please note- there is no right to accreditation. It is also possible that the organizers of the March of Life e.V. may exercise their house regulatory rights.

Business cards or House IDs of a broadcaster, editorial office or company cannot be accepted as proof of accreditation.
